BARB DAVIS SEMINARS

Barb Davis is a 10 time Agility World Team member with 6 different dogs and has won 9 Agility National Championships with 5 different dogs, 4 shelties and a border collie.

Masters+: Skills for Premier and International Handling: This seminar will present courses that have higher level challenges. After walking the course Barb will discuss what handling options are useful in various sequences as well as discuss creating a dog path that keeps the dog running smooth and minimizing off courses. Also, options will be presented for less speedy handlers. Barb will explain techniques and footwork in detail. Participants will run their dogs on sections of the course to familiarize themselves with a particular move. On the next turn they will run the whole course, integrating the info. **(March 13th 8:30 -12:00 5 participants.)**



Masters: Lines & Landings, Effecting the Dogs Landing, to Maximize Course Flow: If a dog lands a jump headed towards the next obstacle they are more likely to stay on a smooth course, and avoid off-courses, AND a big bonus! Many dogs speed up because of gaining confidence, knowing where they are going sooner! Barb will work with participants to smooth out their crosses to help achieve accurate landing direction, as well as how to use their running path to set lines to achieve this same goal. **(March 13th 1:00 – 4:30 5 participants.)**

Novice/Intermediate: In this seminar participants will work on ideas for keeping their dog's motivated and happy. Attention will be given to smoothing out the handler's crosses and keeping connection with the dog while performing them. Techniques of crosses will be discussed and practiced. Handling obstacle discrimination will also be discussed and practiced. Dogs should be familiar with all agility obstacles, but not necessarily proficient. **(March 14th 8:30 – 12:00 5 participants.)**

Young Dogs, 5 months and up: Participants will do short sequences of jumps and tunnels. Topics will include how to build fundamental cues, such as out, go-on, and turn-away. Also, building handler awareness of line-setting, ideas on how to keep their young dogs motivated and interested. Jump bars will be on the ground or low, depending on dog's age and experience. **(March 14th 1:00 – 4:30 5 participants.)**
